MINUTES OF MEETING Mar 18, 2020

CALL TO ORDER

The Regular Meeting of the County Board, was called to order at 6:00 p.m. in the Conference Room in the Campbell Building, 901 Public Square, Benton, Illinois by Chairman Randall Crocker.

This position is fully funded by Hazardous Materials Emergency Preparedness Grant which includes salary and fringes.

TECHNICAL SERVICES - AGREEMENT

Chairman Randall Crocker stated that the next item on the agenda is the agreement for Technical Services and Assistance. He explained that this agreement is between Franklin County, Illinois and Moran Economic Development LLC for the enterprise zone.

HAZARDOUS MATERIAL REMOVAL

Chairman Randall Crocker read the procedure that will take place for this scope of work is required to be completed before building demolition.
