Please allow me to give an updated report to you concerning the Franklin County Senior Services Meal Program currently being conducted at Franklin Hospital.

Since its inception in October 2013, the meal program has served 9600 meals, currently averaging around 538 meals per month. We can provide these meal numbers, broken down into monthly meal counts, in a spreadsheet if you wish.

We run a four week rotational cycle menu with many diverse entrée options that have a traditional popularity. These menu offerings seem to be well received by most patrons and we are pleased to help the seniors of Franklin County.

We are currently charging \$ 3.00 per meal. Most patrons choose to dine in, but there are options available for takeout meals as well.

The service times are Monday through Friday with the hours set at 11:00 am to 1:00 pm.

We are also appreciative of the support of the County Board helping with the expenses of such a service. Together we have helped many people who might have otherwise done without.
