Regional Superintendent of Schools, Matt Donkin stated if the State Budget is not resolved soon his department would lose \$80,000.00.

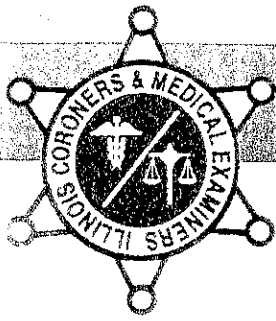
Franklin County Coroner, Marty Leffler submitted a three month report for his office, a copy of said reports are hereby attached as a part of these minutes.

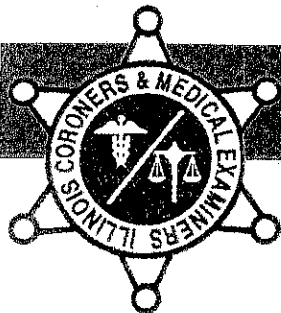
