FRANKLIN COUNTY FINANCIAL REPORT (CASH BASIS) July & August 2015

I. GENERAL COUNTY REVENUE

The end of August marks the completion of 2/3 of our fiscal year. Our sales tax payments continue to come in lower than budgeted. Also, we have been notified that we can no longer expect to be reimbursed for the salaries of the State's Attorney, Public Defender, and Supervisor of Assessments until the state has a budget in place. I am encouraged by the fact that 2/3 into the fiscal year, we have received nearly 70% of our major revenue budget. However, for the year, we have expended \$139,000 more than we have received.
