RULES OF THE COUNTY BOARD

1ST Calling the roll and disposing of the minutes of the last meeting; presentation of petitions, communications and reports, all of which shall be laid before the Board before being referred to the respective committees.

2ND Report of standing committees resolutions and unfinished business. All questions relating to priority of business shall be decided by the Chairman without debate.

3RD Every member before speaking shall rise and address the Chairman.

4TH No member shall speak more than twice upon any one question without the unanimous consent of the Board and shall be limited to ten minutes on the first speech and five minutes on the last speech.

5TH Every member present shall vote upon all questions, except where interested or excused by the Board.

6TH All motions shall be reduced to writing when requested by the Chairman or demanded by any member.

7TH All Committees shall be appointed by the Chairman unless otherwise provided by the Board.

8TH All Committees shall report in writing their findings and recommendations thereon by a majority of such committees, and the minority of any Committee may have the right to report.

9TH There shall be 3 standing committees, consisting of 5 or more members, each viz.

1. Finance, Salaries.
2. Road and Bridge, Public Buildings.
3. Health & Environment, Zoning, Rabies, C. D., & Insurance.

10TH On motion a special committee shall be appointed by the Chairman to transact business for this Board.

11TH Any motion before the Board may be withdrawn at any time before the vote is taken by consent of the mover and second.

12TH A majority of the members of this Board shall constitute a quorum and may transact of business.

13TH Any and all questions coming before the Board shall be decided by a majority of the members of the Board present.

14TH Vote on any motion or proposition before the Board shall be a yea or nay vote.

15TH All claims filed against the county may be audited at the regular and special meetings of the Board.

16TH A motion to adjourn shall always be in order and shall be decided without debate unless a question of time occurs.

17TH These rules may be suspended by a vote of two-thirds of the members present in cases of emergency.

18TH No alteration shall be made to any of the rules of this Board except by consent of a majority of the members of the Board, any and all questions arising not provided for in the foregoing shall be decided by Parliamentary usage.

19TH The Chairman may at any time assign an extra member to any committee for special duty and in case of controversy, the Chairman of the Board may vote on any Committee actions.
